Enter a peachy state of mind with Auntie Anne's newest limited time offering, Peach Lemonade Frost! This new beverage features Auntie Anne's famous Frozen Lemonade with a taste of peachy paradise. Similar to the Strawberry Lemonade Frost LTO that was launched in April 2019, Peach Lemonade Frost utilizes a vanilla smoothie base layered with Frozen Lemonade and topped with whipped cream and peach syrup. During last year's Frost campaign, we saw an increase of 6.9% in daily net sales of the overall beverage category. Due to these results, we're bringing back Lemonade Frost in 2020 and adding a peachy twist!

All stores in the system, are required to sell Peach Lemonade Frost.

The Peach Lemonade Frost campaign will kick off on July 6 and run through Oct. 4, 2020. POP kits will be shipped to arrive the week of June 29 at all open stores. With an average check of \$16.14, customers have the great opportunity to order our product and have it delivered right to their door. With this being said, there are a few things your stores can do to make sure this goes as smoothly as possible:

- Please keep tablets charged/volume up and close to rolling counter or POS for vendors not integrated with **0L0**
- Always have someone in the store front or in the kiosk to be on alert for any incoming orders.
- All 3pd orders should be made with fresh product to ensure our 30 minute quality guarantee
- Remember to seal delivery orders with a 3pd tamperproof delivery seal to close bag and attached-make sure you don't run out of stickers!
- Keep Justin up to date with store closures and out of stock items to have the hours/menu adjusted as needed
- Remember to Check the Grid as well as Playerlync for more information as well as promotional items that happen from time to time

Instructions on how to complete a test order through OLO

- 1. Open the Auntie Anne's Pretzel Perks App (or download from the app store if you're not already a user).
- 2. Tap Order in the bottom left corner.
- Enter the address for your store, then tap Search Locations.
- 4. Find your store and tap Begin Order.
- 5. You're now on your stores' ordering page where you can view your menu.
 - I strongly encourage taking a hard look at your menu. Are pricing missing from any products? This means that the product key associated with that product is missing a price in Revel. -Justin Vallia
- 6. Place an order (we recommend ordering a dip when placing a test order).
- 7. You will receive an order confirmation to your email.




- Monitoring employee health: temperature screenings and Health Assessments done daily!
- Understand safety precautions in your state/county: talk to your local Health Department if you are unsure of what you required!
