Review articles on the GRID and on PlayerLynk! **COMMUNICATION is KEY!** You must cascade everything down to your staff so they understand and know what standards are expected each shift!

Monitoring Employee Health

It is mandatory that each store has an Employee Health Assessment Log printed and ready for use. Every employee has to complete this log with the manager on their shift. Temperature readings need done at the start of each shift for all employees. Also, every employee must be asked and answer if they have any COVID symptoms (fever, cough, shortness of breath, and/or loss of taste/smell). If they have symptoms they must go home and you need to call HR! This log must be kept in a confidential spot (a binder at the manager's desk is recommended). If someone is sick they cannot come to work! They need to talk to their health care provider and let you know once they have been advised on what to do. Employees need to stay home if they are sick. Please contact HR anything related to COVID for questions or concerns! We are here to help!

Sanitizing/Disinfecting

Make sure to be using the 30 minute disinfecting and sanitizing log! Sanitize high contact food surfaces OFTEN with sanitizer (not bleach). Disinfect (with bleach) areas that are non-food surfaces (like door knobs, door handles, light switches, bathrooms, etc.). Sanitize the customer counter in between each transaction with the sanitizer bottle.

Handwashing and Sanitizer

Hands must be washed OFTEN with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol as an additional safety level. Sanitizer is NOT to replace hand washing!!!! It is an added level of safety.

NOTES FROM LEADERSHIP - 4600

Cloth Masks

These must be worn at all times. It is mandatory! These masks are now part of our AA uniform and must be cleaned daily before working your next shift. Cloth masks are to be a solid color or have an AA or pretzel logo. Masks must be securely covering your nose and mouths. They should not reverse, move or be removed from the face unnecessarily while working. **I have seen and been told masks are taken off in the BOH or they are being worn under noses. Masks are to be worn all the time and cover your nose and mouth. If the mask comes down or off, employees cannot be within 6 feet of each other and it must. Masks should never be shared with others, and again they must be cleaned before each shift! DO NOT USE THE WASHER AND DRYER in the store! Employees must take them home to wash them!

Gloves

Gloves need to be worn at all times. Gloves are used at ALL stations, including the host station. Employees need to wash and sanitize their hands before putting on gloves. When gloves need changed, the employees must wash and sanitize their hands before putting on a new set of gloves. For the host station – if a customer pays with cash, the host must change their gloves, and remember they wash and sanitize their hands before putting on a new set of gloves. If the guest pays with a credit card this transaction is considered contactless and gloves don't have to be changed. But gloves do need to be changed often; employees should not wear the same gloves for entire shift! Even if they stay at the same station most of their shift, they need to change their gloves often.

Social Distancing

Use the stickers we are sending to you on the floor in front of the host station to remind guests of social distancing requirements. Please do you absolute best to social distance employees in your stores. We know space is limited but again do your best!
